ORDINANCE NO 43

AN ORDINANCE TO COLLECT USER FEES FOR FIRE SERVICE

THE TOWNSHIP OF PLAINFIELD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Section is to ensure the health, and safety of the residents of Plainfield Township.

Section 2.

The fire department of the Township shall collect a \$250 user fee from the person or persons who receive the services of the Fire Department each time the department responds to a fire service request.

Section 3.

Any person charged such fee may petition the Township Board for relief from such fee by properly filing a written request with the Township Board within 30 days of receiving such charge.

Section 4.

This Ordinance being necessary for the safety and general welfare of the residents of the Township of Plainfield, it is hereby ordered to take immediate effect.

Section 5.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
