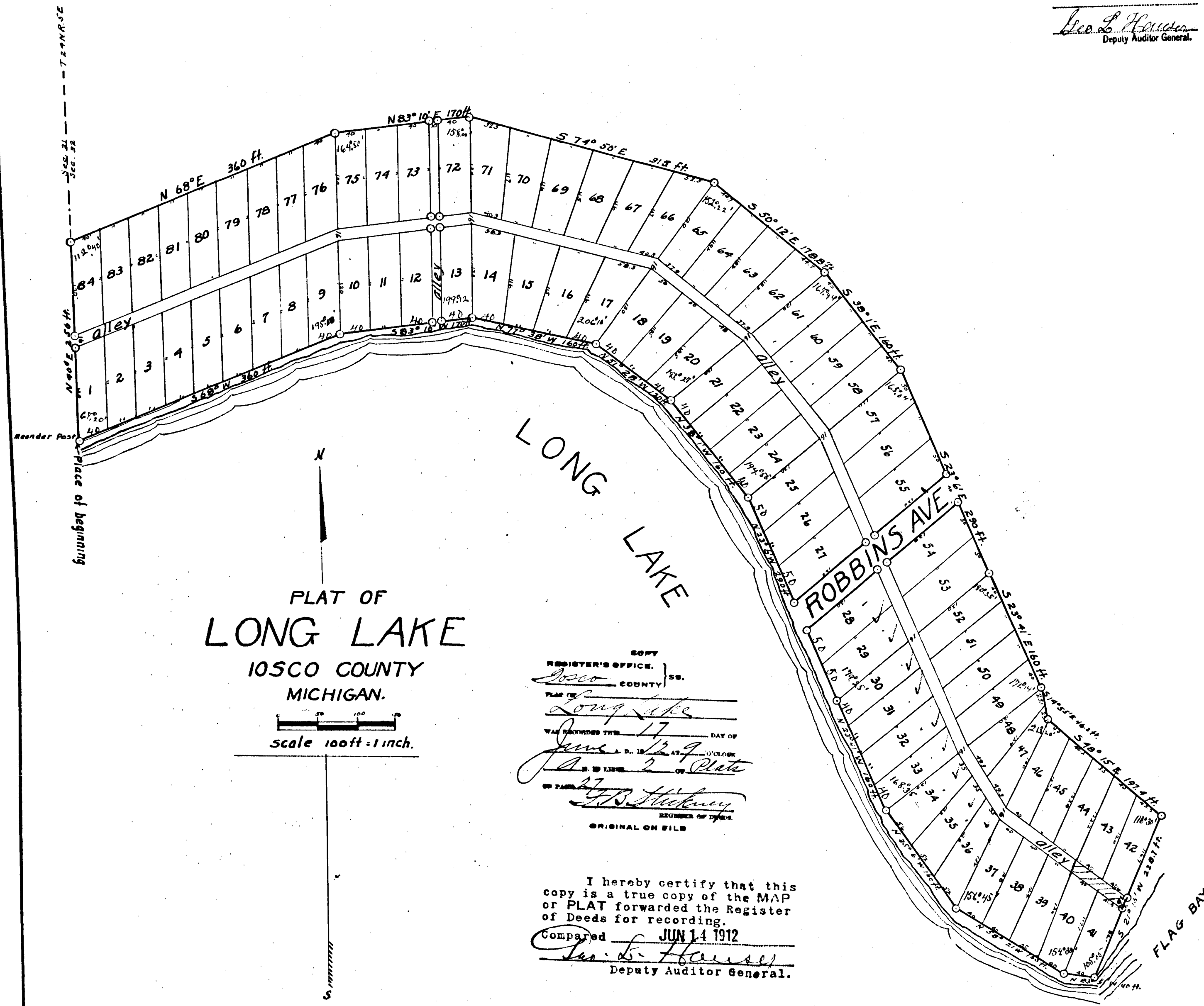

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

Line common to Secs. 31 and 32, thence N 40° E 254 ft.; thence N 68° E 360 ft.; thence N 83° 10' E 170 ft.; thence S 74° 50' E 312 ft.; thence S 50° 12' E 178.8 ft.; thence S 30° 1' E 160 ft.; thence S 23° 6' E 290 ft.; thence S 23° 41' E 160 ft.; thence S 14° 55' E 46.2 ft.; thence S 48° 15' E 197.4 ft.; thence S 21° 15' W 220.7 ft.; thence N 83° 51' W 40 ft.; thence N 53° 21' W 165 ft.; thence N 35° 6' W 160 ft.; thence N 23° 41' W 160 ft.; thence N 23° 6' W 290 ft.; thence N 30° 1' W 160 ft.; thence N 51° 28' W 120 ft.; thence N 77° 38' W 160 ft.; thence S 83° 10' W 170 ft.; thence S 68° W 360 ft. to place of beginning.
