

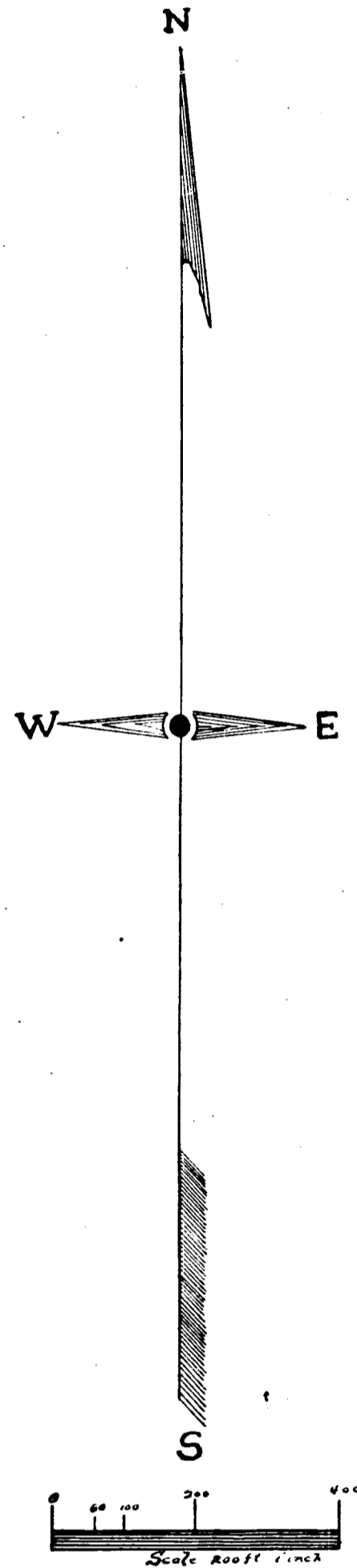
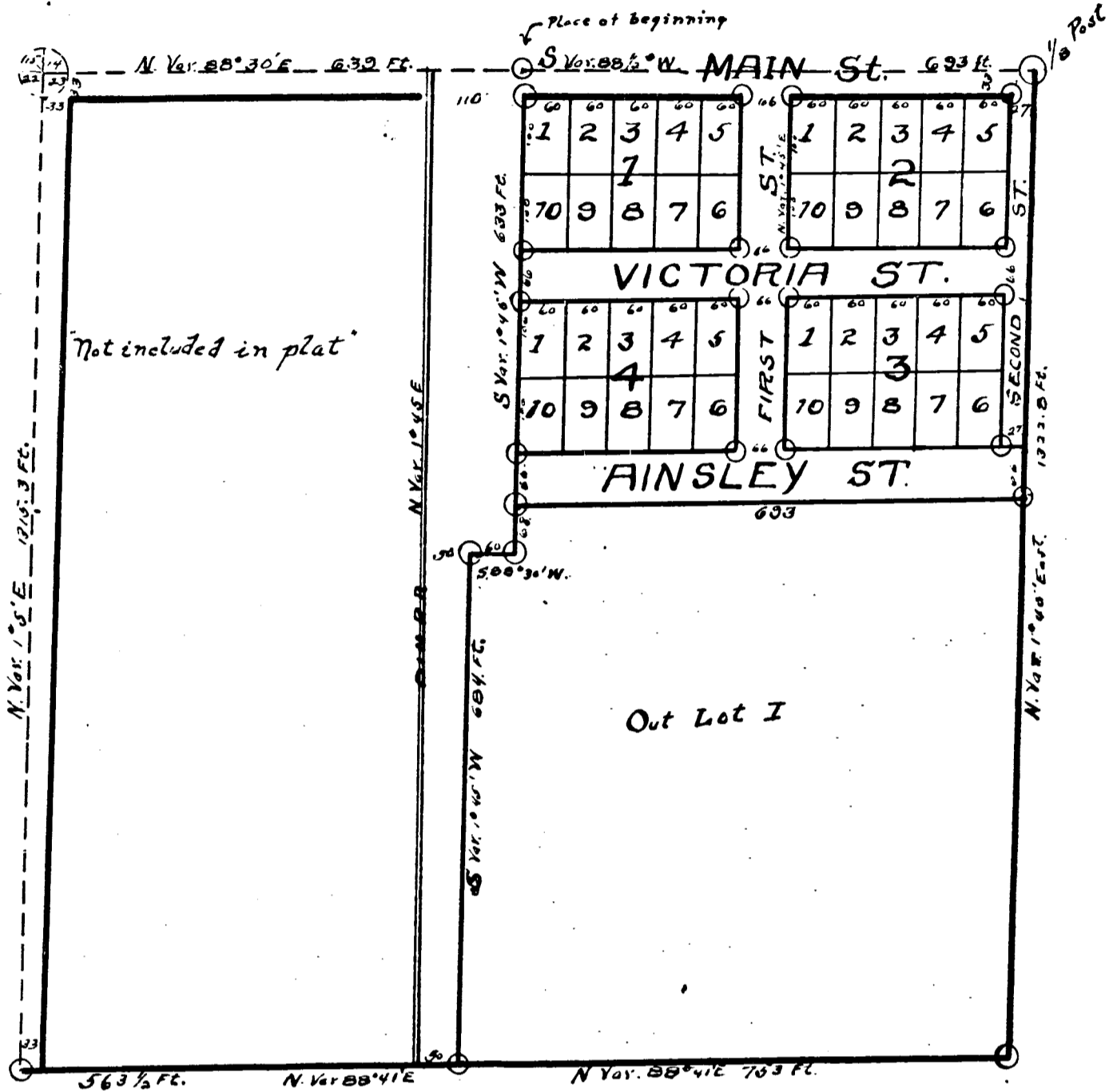

The land embraced in the annexed plat of H. E. Nunn's Plat of the Village of Hale is bounded and described as follows:—A piece of land which is a part of the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section 23 T23 North, Range 5 East. Commencing at a point on the Section Line between Sec's 14 & 23 at a distance of 639 Ft. North Var 88° 30' East of the corner of Sec's 14, 15, 22 & 23 and running thence South, Var 1° 45' West 639 Ft.; thence South, Var 88° 30' West, 60 Ft.; thence South, Var 1° 45' West, 634 Ft.; thence North, Var 88° 41' East along the 1/2 Line a distance of 753 Ft.; and thence North Var 1° 45' East, 13 22.3 Ft.; thence from this 1/2 post, South, Var 88° 30' West, 633 Ft. along the Section Line between Sec's 14 & 23 to the place of beginning. The above bearings are given as the magnetic needle pointed at this date.

Know All Men by these Presents, That we H. E. Nunn as proprietor, and Victoria his wife, have caused the land embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed, laid out and platted, to be known as H. E. Nunn's Plat of the Village of Hale and that the streets and alleys as shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
