DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of ELLAKE is described as follows: An irregular piece of land located on the S.W. Bank of Long Lake in Lot 7, Sec. 5, T23N, R5E being bounded as follows

Beginning at a point which is N43°10'E 1218 ft of the one-quarter post between Secs. 5 and 6 thence N35°E 165 ft; thence N61°31'W 109.5 ft; thence N71°44'W 212 ft; thence N58°55'W 212 ft; thence S35°E 160 ft; thence S63°58'E 530 ft to place of beginning.

The bearings of lines as recorded on this plat are based on the magnetic bearing of compass needle and transit angles.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one, and that permanent monuments consisting of one inch galvanized iron pipe, eighteen inches long have been planted at points marked thus o as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted.

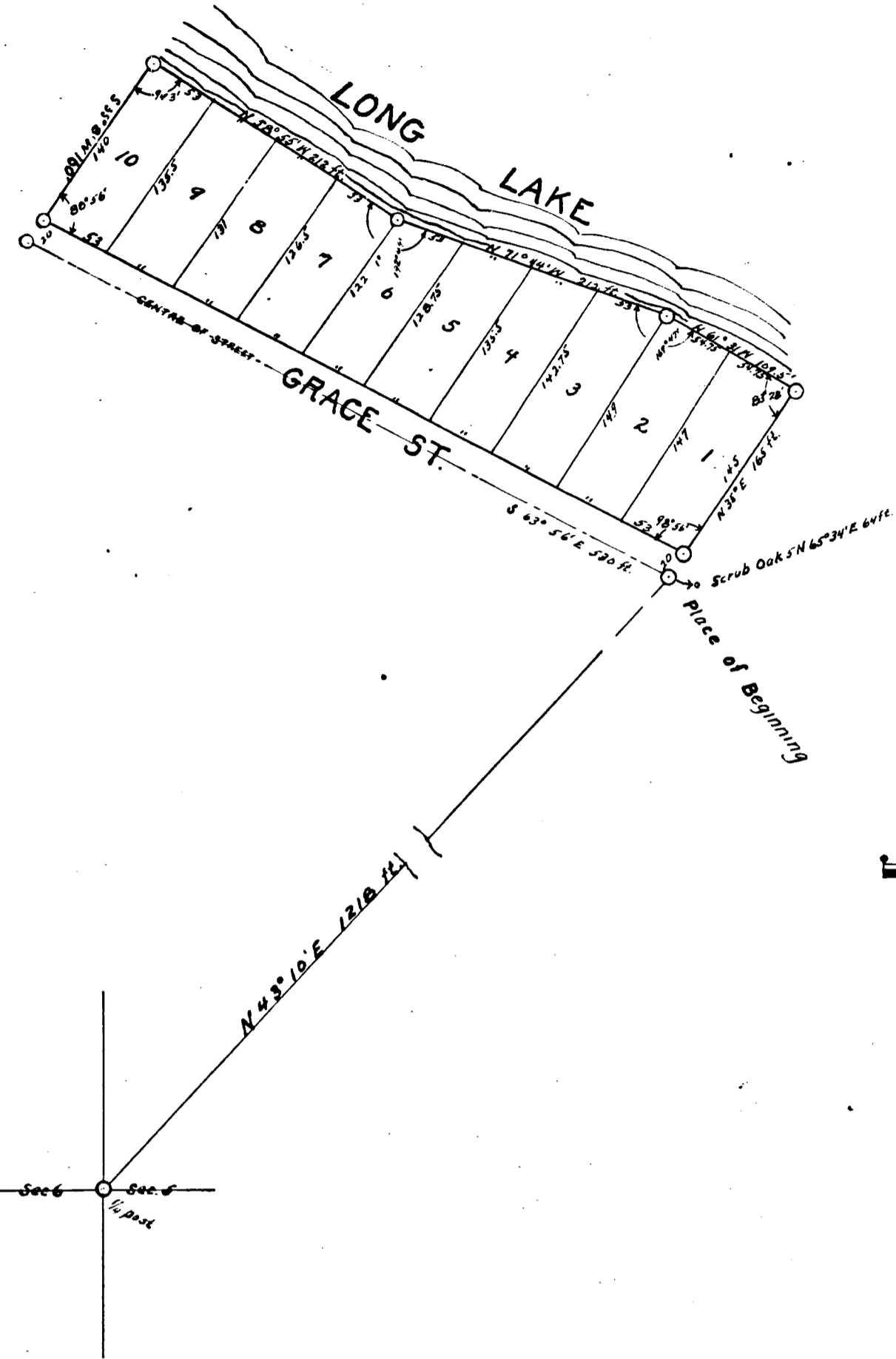
