DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Twin Lakes Subdivision of Part of Lot 1, sec. 35, T.23N. R.6E. Plainfield Twp., Iosco County, Michigan, is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is N. 0° 03' W. 395 ft. from the S.E. Corner Sec. 35, T.23N. R.6E. thence S. 88° 15' W. 552 ft. to the shore of Little Island Lake, thence along said shore N. 7° 20' W. 300 ft., thence N. 67° 43' W. 607.4 ft., thence North 296.4 ft. to County Road, thence along said County Road, N. 71° 12' E. 153.6 ft., thence S. 87° 44' E. 316.4 ft., thence N. 62° 22' E. 366.6 ft., thence S. 87° 44' E. 507 ft., thence S. 0° 03' E. 1063.9 ft. to point of beginning.

Bearings of lines on this plat are based on transit angles and Compass bearings. The declination set at 4° 05' W.

Dimensions are in feet and decimals thereof.
All lots bordering on Lake are to run to the water.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat herein delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 48 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches, with an over-all length of not less than 12 inches, encased in a concrete cylinder of least 4 inches in diameter and having depth equal to one-third of diameter, (R. C.), are set out on all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at all the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, and at all the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
