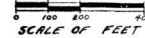
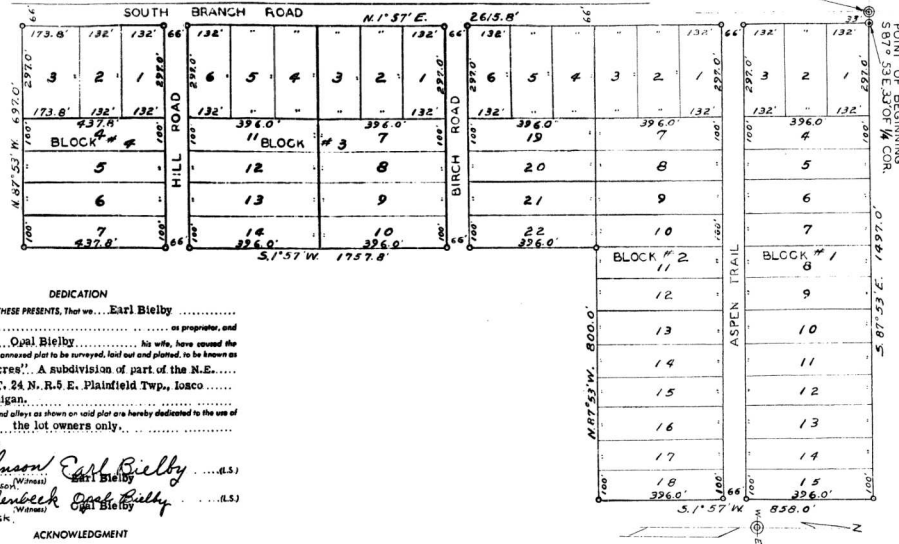

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED
 The land embraced in the annexed plat of "Woodsite Acres". A subdivision of part of the N.E. 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 24 N. R. 5 E., Plainfield Twp., Iosco County, Michigan.
 It is described as follows:
 Beginning at a point S. 87°53' E. 33 ft. from the N. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 31, T. 24 N. R. 5 E., thence S. 87°53' E. 1491 ft., thence S. 1°57' W. 858 ft., thence N. 87°53' W. 800 ft., thence S. 1°57' W. 1757.8 ft., thence N. 87°53' W. 637.0 ft., thence N. 1°57' E. 2615.8 back to the point of beginning.
 All dimensions are given in feet and decimals thereof. All Bearings are bases on Magnetic Readings and Transit Angles computed therefrom.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
 I hereby certify that the plat herein delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 40 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 5 inches with an over-all length of not less than 40 inches, inserted in a concrete cylinder of least 4 inches in diameter and 40 inches in depth have been placed at points marked thereon as shown on all angles in the boundaries of the land plotted, at all the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, at all streets and alleys, and at the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
