Ready/ Lewis explained how the process will proceed, members of board to discuss

Johnson: Master plan: looking at the interest of public in the plan: is this going to benefit the community to change the zoning. 25% of respondents said they would want to see more campgrounds

Houthoofd: looking at fixing the zoning map: moving the ordinance to update the zoning book.

Szafran: changing maps and the ordinance only

Toth: Struggle to see as commercial, just wanting the map to be clarified

Olmstead: thought it was already commercial, wants to create buffer zone across the street. 2017, camping ordinance, now just updating to put in the correct place in the book

Alward: something they were already looking at, many areas in township need to be clarified

Motion by Johnson, supported by Alward; to send amendment to zoning map and ordinance to Plainfield Township Board for approval. Motion carried by Roll Call Vote: ayes: Toth, Johnson, Olmstead, Houthoofd, Ready, Alward, Szafran nayes: none

- 8. New Business: Signs Section 20- complete rewrite: Lewis will give copies to committee to work on for March meeting. LED sign highway advertising Act: 253.318 Prohibited signs or sign structures. Concern with lighted signs 3 ft candles of difference. Asked how to measure: there is an app for that. Like the chart idea to aid in the regulation of signs.
